


The Story Behind BELLOSGUARDO

Last year, local historical tour guide John Ummel charmed VISTAS audiences with his presentation on "Things About Santa Barbara's Past I Never Knew!" John has now put together a new program—"The Story Behind Bellosguardo: The Reclusive Huguette Clark and How Santa Barbara Acquired a Gem of an Estate"—based on the N.Y. Times best-selling book *Empty Mansions*, by Bill Dedman. John has received permission from the author to relate the story of Huguette Clark, the reclusive heiress to a copper fortune who lived out the last 20 years of her life in a New York City hospital, and her Bellosguardo Estate, which has been vacant—but left in its original condition—since 1953. John has acquired over 100 photos from the author that are not widely available and have rarely been seen by the public. Come join us for what is sure to be a fascinating story!


