From Paganini to Lang Lang, virtuoso instrumental performance has had an uneasy position in European and American concert life. Astonishing feats of technical brilliance have always been fascinating and popular,

but also regarded as inferior to more "serious" approaches and repertoires. This seminar will discuss the

origins of this phenomenon in the second quarter of the 19th century, starting with the violinist Nicolò Paganini, rumored to have gained his powers through a deal with the devil, moving on to the 1837 Paris "duel" between the pianist Franz Liszt and Sigismond Thalberg, and concluding with the virtuosa Clara Wieck Schumann and the tours of European virtuosi to the New World.
